Job Description

The Aquatics Director is responsible for developing, implementing, promoting and supervising year round aquatics programs for MICC members of all skill levels and ages. The Director will provide access to a wide variety of activities, with special emphasis placed on instruction, water safety, recreation, fitness training and water sports.

Key Responsibilities

- Responsible for planning, developing, maintaining and evaluating all aquatic programs encompassing all levels of ability and interest of the membership. These programs include, but are not limited to: recreational swimming, dive team, water polo, water aerobics, masters swimming, water safety programs and swim lessons.
- Responsible for running an organized year-round swim team program for both competitive and recreational swimmers.
- Manage the operating budget for all aquatic related activities to ensure the budget projections are met.
- Responsible for coordinating and supervising all pool maintenance.
- Responsible for hiring, supervising, train and scheduling of all lifeguards and coaching staff.
- Responsible for running/ instructing a variety of Aquatics programs.

Qualifications

- College degree in recreation or a closely related field, 2 years experience in management, operations and maintenance of an aquatic facility, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Valid Washington State Drivers License.
- Must be a Certified Pool Operator or ability to obtain within six (6) months of employment.
- Must have current CPR/First Aid/AED certifications or ability to obtain within 60 days of employment.
- Must have current Water Safety/ Lifeguard certifications.
- Current Water Safety instructor's Authorization Certificate (WSI).
- Knowledge of pool chemistry.
- Knowledge of United States Swimming, Diving and Water Polo rules and regulations.
- Considerable knowledge of recreation philosophy, planning and administration.
- Ability to work night and weekends as needed.
- Ability to work independently.
